


Sanitize your hands before the worship service.

Would You Consider Making a Gift of Stock to the Church?

You may be aware of the new record highs these days in the stock market. Whether we understand it, or even like it, it does provide an opportunity to those fortunate enough to have stock investments when it come to donations. Some parishioners have used this over the years, and it is definitely a “win-win.”

The basic concept is that “appreciated” stock (with a current value higher than its original cost) can be donated directly to the church, and the full current value of the donation can be taken as a charitable donation for tax purposes without having to pay taxes on the increase in the value of the stock that would otherwise be due if the stock were sold first.
