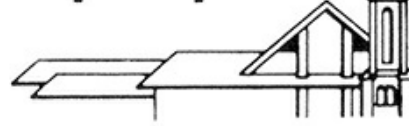

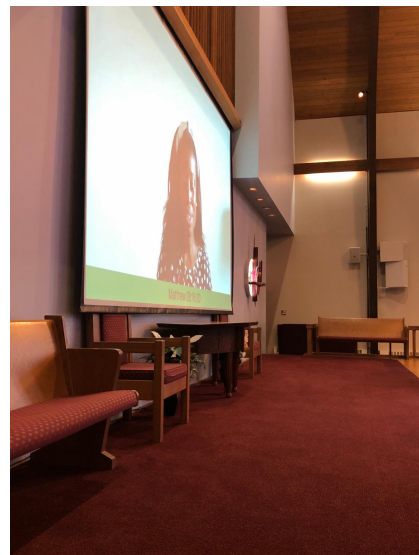

Harborlight Nursery School Is Seeking Volunteer To Join HNS Board



Harborlight Nursery School (fun fact: HNS is our original satellite ministry here at First Baptist, and a beloved institution within early childhood circles in our area!) is currently seeking a volunteer to serve as a new Board member. Those interested in this position should have a financial background and be willing to be trained for/step into the role of Board Treasurer, with a commitment of at least 3 years.

The duties and responsibilities for this position include budgeting, maintaining the financial accounts, reporting balance sheet, profit & loss at Board meetings, and providing the outside

accountant with information for tax preparation. The estimated time commitment per month is 2 hours at home and attendance at a monthly Board meeting. There are times when additional time is required, such as when creating the budget or at tax time. The ideal scenario would be to have a member of the church serve in this role, but it is not necessary.

Would You Consider Making a Gift of Stock to the Church?

You may be aware of the new record highs these days in the stock market. Whether we understand it, or even like it, it does provide an opportunity to those fortunate enough to have stock investments when it comes to donations. Some parishioners have used this over the years, and it is definitely a “win-win.”

The basic concept is that “appreciated” stock (with a current value higher than its original cost) can be donated directly to the church, and the full current value of the donation can be taken as a charitable donation for tax purposes without having to pay taxes on the increase in the value of the stock that would otherwise be due if the stock were sold first.
