

We would love to please receive any donations by Monday, October 23rd so we know how much candy we will need to purchase to supplement donations. Thank you!





#### **Providing Affordable Homes**

Minister Daniel Johnson has urged us "to hold firm to the HOPE which our Lord has placed before us" – a call for the regeneration and fulfillment of hope in the lives of all people.

For over the past 60 years, our membership of FBC has embraced this appeal for hope through its commitment to end the scourge of homelessness with the existing and proposed development of 900 housing units which provide for an affordable and secure home for nearly 1,250 people residing throughout the North Shore Region.

At the recommendation of your Board of Trustees, our Church Council now intends to consider a program opportunity proposed by Harborlight Homes, entitled "The Lighthouse Center." This program will provide for the introduction of supportive community services designed to sustain a fulfilling and expanding housing mission addressing this now urgent regional housing priority..

The Church Council will meet on Sunday, October 29 immediately following our worship service and act upon a recommendation by the Trustees.
