

Last Sunday's service honoring Esther Changs's remarkable 25 years as Music Director and organist at First Baptist Church was a reminder that music has always been an important, even essential, part of worship at the church. When the church suffered its devastating fire back in 1975, the budget only included money for the restoration of two-thirds of the organ. The moderator at the time Bob Currier (Cindie Boccia's dad) made an eloquent plea at an all-church meeting for funds to finish the remaining third, and the congregation responded generously, giving us the complete organ that we enjoy today.

It is your pledges that make our wonderful music program possible. When you buy a ticket to a concert, you're only paying for one performance. But when you make a pledge to the church, you're supporting the entire music program, even the often unseen and unglamourous part such as Esther's FICA tax, stipends for special musicians, repairs to the organ when needed, annual tune-ups for the two pianos, scads of sheet music, and repairs for the unexpected leak in the choir loft ceiling. Your pledge supports all the other very special programs of the church, and so much more.

This Sunday when we celebrate Thanksgiving Sunday, there will be a time to submit pledge cards into the replica of the church which was artfully handcrafted by former deacon Max Raines, along with a dedication of them to God's service by the ministers. Pledge cards are available in the pew racks, *on the church website* or through the mail. What better way to express gratitude to the church than by making a pledge to support its continuing service in 2024?




