


#### Quick Mid-Year Meeting Preview leading into our \*NEW\* Monthly FBC Feature:

them in time for our Mid-Year meeting at 11:30 am on Sunday, January 28th - directly after worship.


Finally, we have the "green light" to meet together as a church on these following dates:
